Spring 2017 Art Exhibit & Revue

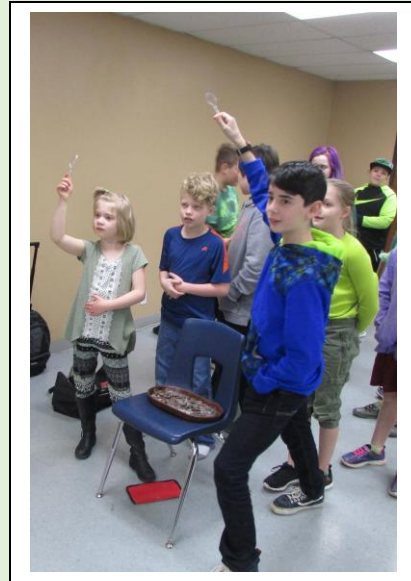
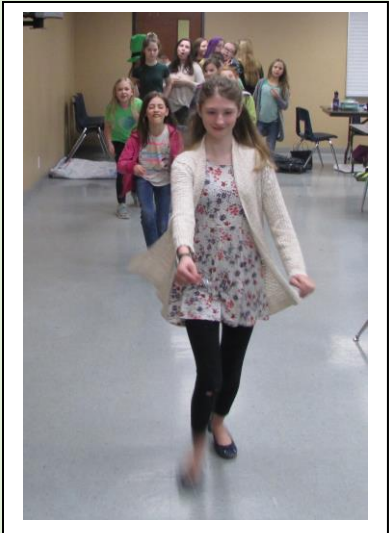
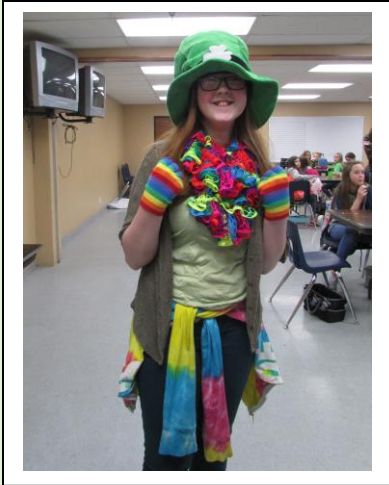

It's time to begin thinking about our end of the year Art Exhibit & Revue. Our students and teachers always get excited at this time when we begin to see their creations come to life. The students are working hard on finishing their projects in each class and will soon be ready for their mats.

Most of our artwork requires a mat that will fit a 9x12 Bristol board. The closest that fits this size that is sold in stores are an 11x14 (outside cut), with an 8x10 (inside cut). These can be purchased at your local art stores, Michaels, and we have also seen them sold at Fred Meyers. Black works best for drawings, but any color is acceptable.

We are excited about holding a silent auction the night of our exhibit. This will be our first silent auction held during this time. We need for families to donate items to be auctioned off. Please nothing used, broken, torn or stained. We would like to have new or like-new items, gift certificates, etc. The highest bidder wins and the item can be taken home that night.

We also have a lot of items in our lost & found – clothing, lunch bags/pails, and even artwork from previous exhibits. We will have a table displayed at our exhibit with these items.
