

Scholarship Recipients

Qualifications:

There are several considerations or guidelines in helping us to decide who qualifies for a scholarship. We regret we have limited funds and must decide who will or will not receive a scholarship and how much each recipient will receive. No one will be refused a scholarship based on race. Qualifications will be based on:

1. Income
2. Hardships
3. Recommendations
4. Past school record (commitment, work, and ethics). Students who work hard, show commitment to their studies, and respectful behavior will more likely be considered in the following term for a scholarship.
5. Families that volunteer will be given preference for future scholarships.
6. Fundraising (i.e. Calendars, Auctions) participation is required for all scholarship recipients.

Scholarship Recipients will be given a semester assessment for future qualification for a scholarship.

Scholarships are decided by the School Board
