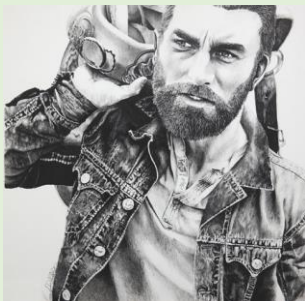

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### MSOA STUDENT/TEACHER POLICY

For those enrolling in the school year 2017-18 may want to view our school policy.

#### Teachers:

1. Teachers are not allow to meet with underage students outside of school hours or off campus unless their parent is with them. Field trips only with signed off campus release forms.
2. Teachers are not allowed to text students, or call them on personal matters. There needs to be a separation between underage students and adult teacher (or anyone over the age of 18).
3. Teachers are not allowed to push Pet doctrines or political views in the classroom, on the MSOA Campus and not without parental input (for underage students). For example, you can't invite them to your church or social groups.
4. Teachers involved in gossip or slander will be put on probation and if it continues they will be asked to leave. One warning for this behavior.
5. Teachers must be prepared for class, not late, and attentive to the kids. They can have fun in the classroom, but must get the work done.
6. Teachers are expected to finish up their work by crazy day, and have students work prepared for the exhibit.
7. Teachers must be an example of Godly behavior. They should not dress provocative. They need not wear anything dark. Need to be professional in behavior and dress.

#### Students:

1. Must stay in the classroom, unless teacher permits students to go to the office or restroom.
2. Students are to be dressed appropriately for school. If they wear leggings, they need to wear a skirt over it. No suggestive clothing.
3. Music can't be shared.
4. Students are to be prepared with paints, pencils, etc.
5. Students who are disruptive in class will be given different work or asked to go to the office. Students who can't focus will be given work to help them focus.
6. Students must wait for their parents either in a classroom, office area or outside of the stairs on the bench.
7. Underage students cannot leave the MSOA campus during school hours.
