Tuition Increase

Due to the increase in minimum wage this year, we need to increase our monthly tuition costs to help compensate the raises to some of our staff. This increase will begin our Fall 2018 term.

While we are happy to offer more salary to our incredible staff, who is very deserving, we depend on our tuition income to help pay for our overhead. Because of this, our tuition will be raised \$5 across the board. We are hoping only raising it \$5 per student will not be too much of a burden on our families. Thank you for your understanding!

Our registration and supply fees have not been raised in cost at this time.

New Tuition Costs:

1 Class = \$55/month
 2 Classes = \$105/month
 3-5 Classes = \$155/month
 Full-Time (both days) = \$279/month

Cost: \$150 (plus \$50 for paint kit)

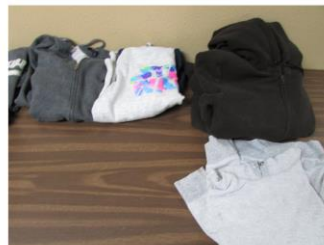
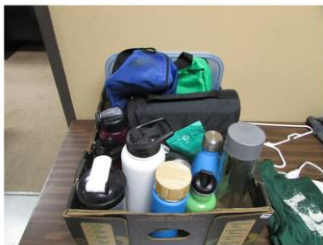
Age limit: 13 & Up

Please remember that all artwork must be matted or framed for the exhibit (unless otherwise directed by their instructor). Paintings do not need to be framed. Be sure to check and see that your child's name, age, and class is written on the back of each art piece. We need this information for labeling the artwork to prepare for the voting contest. If you decide to frame your child's work, please do not put it behind glass as this makes it difficult to get a good picture during artwork prep day.

Our Art Exhibit & Revue is our final wrap up of the term and is a required event of all families. Students must present at least 1 artwork from each of their classes. This is a great time to invite your friends and family and to get a good idea of the amazing talent of MSOA students and staff. We are so proud of everyone for doing another amazing job!

If you haven't yet registered for our Fall 2018 term, you have until May 31st to get your registration paperwork and fee to us to be considered pre-registered. It's important to get in on pre-registration so you will have first pick of our classes we will be offering. Many of our classes fill and close during pre-registration enrollment, so be sure to get us the required paperwork, and mail in your registration fee to our PO Box very soon!

We are very excited about our new way of registering beginning our Fall term. We have set up "online registration" on our website now, so the only thing you need to mail in is your registration fee.
