Tuition & Supply Fee Increase

Tuition:

1 Class = \$50/month
 2 Classes = \$100/month
 3-5 Classes = \$150/month
 Full-Time (both days) = \$270/month

Supply Fee: (due once a term)

1 Class = \$15
 2 Classes = \$25
 3-5 Classes = \$35
 Full-Time (both days) = \$45

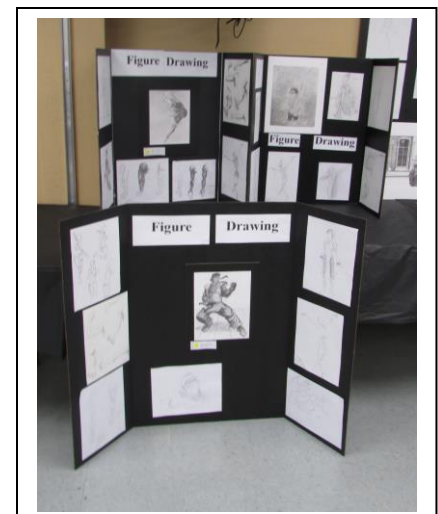
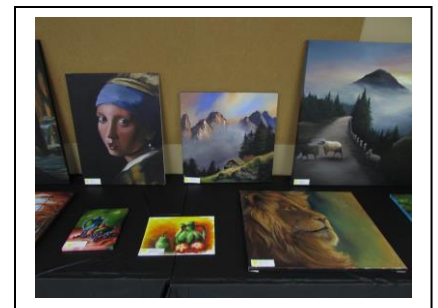
Office Manager Position Available
